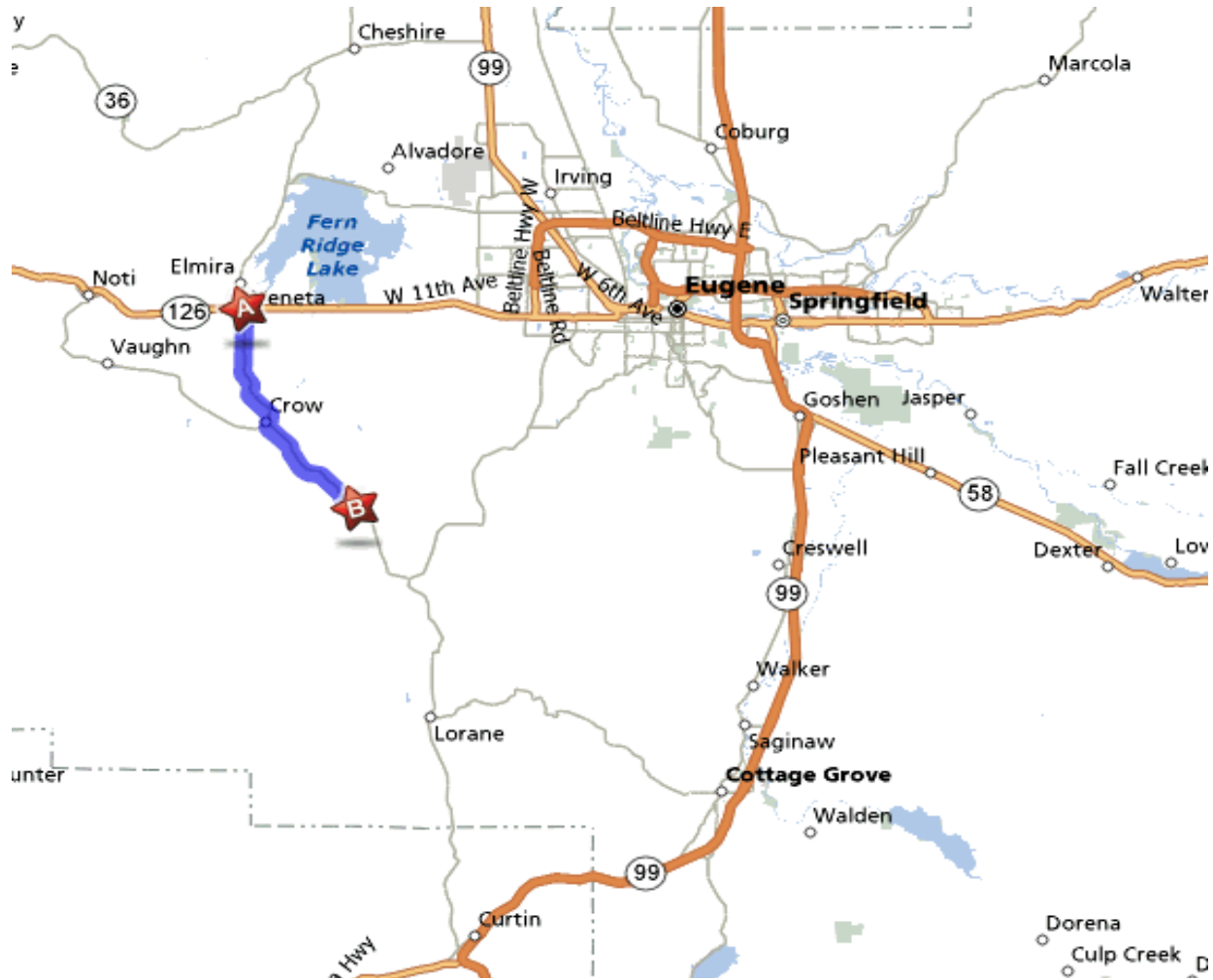

FUML Broken Wagon Rendezvous Rules

- All FUML Range rules apply .Follow the 10 Ten Commandments.
- No loading out of powder horn .Use measuring device ONLY
- NO SMOKING on any of the trails.
- Groups of four (4 or more)at a time. No more than 2 shooters per gun.
- Load only at the station, which you are shooting. Please do not carry loaded guns between stations.
- Cap or Prime at the firing line only.(1) shooter at a time.
- Shots must be taken within a arms length of the station stake, to right or left side.
- Round ball with wet patch only (**no greased patches**)Non flammable ONLY.
- Open Iron sights, no covered sights.
- Parents will be held responsible for their children.
- **Juniors or Pee Wee must have an adult with them at all times**
- All shots are off-hand. Pee Wees must use shooting stick
- Throwing of hawks & knives in designated areas only.
- No pacing off targets, including hawk or knife
- Hawk must make 1 full turn before hitting the target
- Bow & Arrow rules will be discussed at morning shooter meetings.
- Primitive dress is strongly encouraged during this event. EXTRA points will be given for primitive dress. 3 items or more.

- **Please Conserve the water *** Be mindful to not leave faucets running**
- **Dogs must be leashed at ALL times** and owners pick up after them. This area is full of both wildlife and livestock. **NO DOGS allowed on trails 8AM – 4PM**
- Please keep campfires under control, Indian fire NOT Whiteman fire.
- Buckets of water and shovel for fire. **Be prepared for alternative cooking fuel due to fire ban if required.** Some firewood will be available or you can bring in your own. There will be a group campfire nightly in main camp. If we are on fire ban... no individuals campfires will be allowed.
- Please keep the primitive area, looking primitive.
- No vehicles are allowed to stay in the primitive or modern area: after unloading please park in the designated area .We will have a shuttle to and from if needed.
- No offensive language please.
- Be respectful of your neighbors.
- **GENERATOR HOURS 10AM – 5PM*** in camp**** You may stay in lower parking lot with no restrictions on generator use if desired.
- No alcoholic beverages to be consumed prior to or during shooting.
- Please pick up all trash – help to keep this area clean, if you packed it in, pack it out. This includes the piles from doggy too 😊
